

CWDC Induction Standards: Training Format for Standard 1

Standard 1: Understand the principles and values essential for fostering children and young people.

1. Principles and values
 - a) Show your awareness of the principles and values essential for looking after children, young people and their families. Store the principles and values statement in your file, complete a 'what have I learnt sheet.'
 - b) Demonstrate how you promote the above principles and values: complete 'promoting principles and values' worksheet.

2. Equality, inclusion and anti-discriminatory practice
 - a) Understand the different types of prejudice and discrimination which can affect children and young people. Complete worksheet 'prejudice and discrimination' worksheet.
 - b) Understand why it is important to provide care which preserves each child's background. Partly cross-referenced to 5.2 a) and answer question in workbook –'where can you get advice about the care needs of a child or young person who has a different racial, cultural or religious background to your own?'
 - c) As 1.2, a.

3. Person-centred approaches
 - a) Be able to explain how your care relates to the five outcomes in Every Child Matters
 - b) Give examples of how you take account of the experiences, preferences, wishes and needs of individual children and young people and their families. Answer question in workbook.
