PLAN:MK SCHEDULE OF MAIN MODIFICATIONS

Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004

The Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012

Milton Keynes Council has published the Plan:MK: Schedule of Main Modifications for a six week period of consultation from **Wednesday 31st October - Wednesday 12th December 2018**.

Plan:MK was submitted to the Planning Inspectorate for examination in March 2018. Following examination hearings held in July and August 2018, the Inspector invited the Council to submit, for his consideration, a schedule of proposed Main Modifications to Plan:MK which he considered to be necessary to make the plan sound.

The schedule is now subject to public consultation.

Title of Document: Plan:MK: Schedule of Main Modifications

Subject matter:

1. Plan:MK sets out proposals for the use of land and policies to guide future development for the Milton Keynes administrative area up to 2031. It sets out:
 - a. The vision and strategic objectives for Milton Keynes
 - b. An approach that promotes the principle of sustainable development
 - c. The strategy for growth in the settlements within Milton Keynes
 - d. A housing target, allocations and policies to deliver the housing target
 - e. Policies and allocations for delivering employment and retail growth to meet identified needs
 - f. A strategic allocation for new higher and further education facilities
 - g. The approach for securing infrastructure delivery to support growth
 - h. Thematic policies on the economy and retail; transport and connectivity; homes and neighbourhoods; education and health; flood risk; the environment, biodiversity and geodiversity; heritage; open space, leisure and recreation; design; sustainable construction and design; and culture and community
 - i. The approach to implementation and monitoring of Plan:MK
2. Plan:MK is supported by a number of appendices and a set of Policies Maps and Inset Maps.
3. The schedule outlines a number of main modifications to the submission version of the Plan that are considered necessary for the Plan to be found sound.

Area covered: Plan:MK Schedule of Main Modifications covers the whole of Milton Keynes Borough administrative area.
