Recycle Matching Pairs is a memory game where you need to match pairs of cards. Playing is very simple - you turn over one card and then try to find the matching card.

Before you start:

- Print off the Matching Pairs Cards below onto thick paper or card, single sided, in colour. Laminate if desired.
- Cut out each card.

How to play matching pairs card game

- 1. Mix up the cards.
- 2. Lay them in rows, face down.
- 3. Turn over any two cards.
- 4. If the two cards match, keep them.
- 5. If they don't match, turn them back over.
- 6. Remember what was on each card and where it was.
- 7. Watch and remember during the other player's turn.
- 8. The game is over when all the cards have been matched.
- 9. The player with the most matching cards wins you are the Recycling Champion!
