

PUBLIC NOTICE

MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (NORTH SIXTH STREET, CENTRAL MILTON KEYNES) (ON-STREET FREE AND LIMITED WAITING AND STANDARD TARIFF PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council proposes to make the above Traffic Regulation Order, under sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2), 4(2) and (3), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The general effect of the Order will be to alter the parking arrangements in North Sixth Street, Central Milton Keynes to introduce free 30-minute limited waiting parking along those parts of the road between the hours of 7.00 am - 8.00 am and 5.00 pm -6.00pm every day of the week.

The parking restrictions will continue to be standard rate tariff and various permit parking between the hours of 9.00 am and 5.00pm every day of the week.

The proposed alterations will help to provide safe and convenient parking for parents attending the Nursery to drop-off and pick-up their children.

As the Highway Authority for the above lengths of road, Milton Keynes City Council is satisfied that the introduction of the above proposed restrictions will help encourage a safer environment throughout.

Milton Keynes Council is now carrying out statutory consultation on the above proposal.
