

PUBLIC NOTICE

MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (LOUGHTON) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING ON FOOTWAY OR VERGE) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to make the above Traffic Regulation Order.

The effect of the above proposed Order will be to introduce a prohibition of waiting on footway or verge restriction in Loughton, an area bounded by Lincslade Gove (from a point 80 metres west of its junction Lucy Lane), Bradwell Lane (from a point 10 metres south of its junction with Leys Road) and Redland Drive (from a point 10 metres north its junction with Ashpole Furlong).

Milton Keynes City Council is now carrying out statutory consultation on the above proposal. Copies of the proposed Order, together with plans showing the general arrangements and a statement of reason, may be inspected on the Council's website at: www.milton-keynes.gov.uk/consultations.
