STATEMENT OF REASONS

(A brief statement of the general nature and effect of the Order)

MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL

(LOUGHTON) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING ON FOOTWAY OR VERGE) ORDER 2023

Milton Keynes City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes to make the above traffic regulation Order.

The effect of the above proposed Order will be to introduce a prohibition of waiting on footway or verge restriction in Loughton, an area bounded by Linceslade Gove (from a point 80 metres west of its junction Lucy Lane), Bradwell Lane (from a point 10 metres metres south of its junction with Leys Road) and Redland Drive (from a point 10 metres north its junction with Ashpole Furlong and will include the footways and verges along the following lengths of road:
