MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, OLD WOLVERTON) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2023

Milton Keynes City Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2) and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

PART 1

IMPLEMENTATION, CITATION AND DEFINITIONS

- This Order shall come into operation on the 16th day of June 2023 and may be cited as "Milton Keynes City Council (Various Roads, Old Wolverton) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2023".
- 2. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings respectively assigned to them:-
 - "access way" means a length of road sufficient to enable a vehicle to have access to and egress from land or premises in or adjacent to the said road;
 - "Civil Enforcement Officer" ("CEO") has the same meaning as in Section 76 of the Traffic Management Act of 2004;
 - "Council" means Milton Keynes City Council;
 - "delivering" and "collecting" in relation to any goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;
 - "disabled persons' badge" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;
 - "disabled persons' vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;
 - "goods" includes postal packets of any description, cash or other valuable securities;
 - "goods vehicle" means a motor vehicle which is constructed or adapted for the carriage of goods of any description and which does not exceed 3.5 tonnes gross laden weight;
 - "passenger vehicle" means a motor vehicle (other than a motor cycle or invalid carriage) constructed solely for the carriage of passengers and their

effects and adapted to carry not more than twelve passengers exclusive of the driver, and not drawing a trailer;

"postal packets" has the same meaning as in Section 125 of the Postal Services Act 2000:

"restricted road" means a road which is subject to parking and waiting restrictions:

"road" means a highway and any other road to which the public has access;

"statutory undertaker" has the same meaning as in Section 329 of the Highways Act 1980;

"telecommunications apparatus" has the same meaning as in the Telecommunications Act 1984;

"traffic sign" means a sign of any size, colour and type prescribed or authorised under, or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under, Section 64 of the Act of 1984.

- 3. Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.
- 4. The plans annexed to this Order identify the roads and areas subject to this Order, provided that where there is any inconsistency between the plans and the Schedules it is the wording of the Schedules which shall prevail.
- 5. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into effect of this Order any provisions of any Orders mentioned in Schedule 3 hereto are hereby revoked to the extent stated in that Part.

PART 2

PROHIBITION OF WAITING

- 6. No person shall except with the permission or under the direction of a police officer in uniform, a traffic warden or a Civil Enforcement Officer (CEO) cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 hereto.
- 7. Nothing in Article 6 above shall render it a contravention of this Order to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 for so long as may be necessary: -
 - (1) to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded from the vehicle;
 - (2) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (3) If the vehicle is a goods vehicle and is delivering and/or collecting;

- (4) when the person in control of the vehicle is required by law to stop or is obliged to stop in order to avoid an accident or is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside his control;
- (5) for a vehicle to wait whilst any gate or other barrier at the entrance to premises to which the vehicle requires access or from which it has emerged is being opened or closed, if it is not reasonably practicable for the vehicle to wait outside otherwise than in a length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order while such gate or other barrier is being opened or closed;
- (6) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot reasonably be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following:
 - a) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - b) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - the laying, erection or repair of any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or any telecommunication system defined by the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - d) use in the service of any undertaker, the Environment Agency or any public authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - e) any wedding or funeral;
 - f) use for police, military, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - g) use for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined by section 125 of the Postal Services Act 2000;
 - h) the vehicle being specially constructed or adapted for the delivery or collection of money or valuable securities to be used for those purposes in relation to premises in the vicinity;
 - i) to carry out the removal of furniture or household effects to or from a shop, office, depository or dwelling house in the vicinity.
- 8. In accordance with the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000, nothing in Article 6 shall render it a contravention of this Order to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays a disabled person's badge and parking disc in the relevant position in accordance with Articles 8 and 9 hereof to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 hereto.
- 9. For the purposes of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying a disabled person's badge in the relevant position under the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 if: -
 - (1) the badge is exhibited on the dashboard or facia of the vehicle so that the front of the badge is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle; or

- (2) where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or facia, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the front of the badge is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle.
- 10. For the purposes of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying a parking disc in the relevant position under the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 if: -
 - (1) the disc is exhibited on the dashboard or facia of the vehicle so that when marked to show the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting began, that period is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle; or
 - (2) where the vehicle does not have a dashboard or facia, the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that, when marked to show the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting began, that period is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle.

PART 3

ENFORCEMENT OF RESTRICTIONS

- 12. The Council shall, on or in the vicinity of a restricted road:-
 - (1) Highlight each restricted area with notices, signs and road surface markings in accordance with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions Act 2002;
 - (2) Maintain and from time to time alter the said notices, signs and roadsurface markings;
 - (3) Carry out such other work as is reasonably required for the purpose of the satisfactory operation of a restricted road.
- 13. The Council shall appoint Civil Enforcement Officers whose duty it shall be to patrol and enforce the waiting and parking restrictions imposed by the Articles of this Order.

SCHEDULE 1

NO WAITING AT ANY TIME

OLD WOLVERTON ROAD AND BRIDGETURN AVENUE

SOUTH SIDE, EAST SIDE AND NORTH SIDE

NW1 From a point on Old Wolverton Road 52 metres east of its junction with the centreline of Bridgeturn Avenue, for a distance of 84 metres in a westerly then southerly then easterly direction along Old Wolverton Road and Bridgeturn Avenue

OLD WOLVERTON ROAD AND BRIDGETURN AVENUE

SOUTH SIDE AND WEST SIDE

NW2 From a point on Old Wolverton Road 23 metres east of its junction with the centreline of Bridgeturn Avenue, for a distance of 42.6 metres in an easterly then southerly direction along Old Wolverton Road and Bridgeturn Avenue

BRIDGETURN AVENUE

EAST SIDE

NW3 From a point 126 metres south-east of its junction with Old Wolverton Road, for a distance of 33.7 metres in southerly a direction

BRIDGETURN AVENUE

SOUTH SIDE

NW4 From a point 74 metres south-east of its junction with Old Wolverton Road, for a distance of 40 metres in an easterly direction

COLTS HOLM ROAD (EASTERN ARM) AND OLD WOLVERTON ROAD

WEST SIDE AND NORTH SIDE

NW5 From a point 17 metres north of its junction with on Old Wolverton Road, for a distance of 66.7 metres in a southerly and westerly direction along Colts Holm Road and Old Wolverton Road

COLTS HOLM ROAD (EASTERN ARM) AND OLD WOLVERTON ROAD

EAST SIDE AND NORTH SIDE

NW6 From a point 17 metres north of its junction with on Old Wolverton Road, for a distance of 37 metres in a southerly and easterly direction along Colts Holm Road and Old Wolverton Road

COLTS HOLM ROAD (EASTERN ARM)

FAST SIDE

NW7 From a point 140.6 metres north of its junction with Old Wolverton Road, for a distance of 113.5 metres in a northerly direction

COLTS HOLM ROAD (EASTERN ARM AND NORTHERN ARM)

WEST SIDE AND SOUTH SIDE

NW8 From a point 140.6 metres north of its junction with Old Wolverton Road, for a distance of 89.5 metres in a northerly then westerly direction

COLTS HOLM ROAD (NORTHERN ARM)

SOUTH SIDE

NW9 From a point 77.5 metres east of the eastern kerbline of the eastern arm of Colts Holm Road, for a distance of 61.5 metres in an easterly direction

COLTS HOLM ROAD (NORTHERN ARM)

SOUTH SIDE

NW10 From a point 224 metres east of the eastern kerbline of the eastern arm of Colts Holm Road, for a distance of 41.5 metres in an easterly direction

COLTS HOLM ROAD (NORTHERN ARM)

SOUTH SIDE

NW11 From a point 235 metres east of the western kerbline of the eastern arm of Colts Holm Road, for a distance of 14 metres in an easterly direction

COLTS HOLM ROAD (NORTHERN ARM)

SOUTH SIDE

NW12 From a point 132 metres east of the western kerbline of the eastern arm of Colts Holm Road, for a distance of 76.5 metres in an easterly direction

COLTS HOLM ROAD (NORTHERN ARM)

SOUTH SIDE

NW13 From a point 103 metres east of the western kerbline of the eastern arm of Colts Holm Road, for a distance of 26.5 metres in an easterly direction

COLTS HOLM ROAD (WESTERN ARM AND NORTHERN ARM)

FAST SIDE AND SOUTH SIDE

NW14 From a point 163 metres north of its junction with Old Wolverton Road, for a distance of 81 metres in a northerly then easterly direction

COLTS HOLM ROAD (WESTERN ARM)

EAST SIDE

NW15 From a point 109 metres north of its junction with Old Wolverton Road, for a distance of 29 metres in a southerly then easterly direction

NW16 From a point 50 metres north of its junction with Old Wolverton Road, for a distance of 18.7 metres in a northerly then easterly direction

COLTS HOLM ROAD (WESTERN ARM) AND OLD WOLVERTON ROAD

EAST SIDE AND NORTH SIDE

NW17 From a point on Colts Holm Road 10 metres north of its junction with Old Wolverton Road, for a distance of 26 metres in a southerly then easterly direction onto Old Wolverton Road

OLD WOLVERTON ROAD & COLTS HOLM ROAD

NORTH SIDE, WEST SIDE AND NORTH SIDE

NW18 From a point on Old Wolverton Road 28.4 metres west of its junction with the centreline of Colts Holm Road (western arm), for a distance of 308 metres in an easterly then northerly then easterly direction along Old Wolverton Road and Clots Holm Road

OLD WOLVERTON ROAD & DICKENS ROAD

NORTH SIDE, WEST SIDE AND SOUTH SIDE

NW19 From a point on Old Wolverton Road 25 metres west of its junction with the centreline of Dickens Road, for a distance of 130 metres in an easterly then northerly then westerly direction along Old Wolverton Road and Dickens Road

DICKENS ROAD

NORTH SIDE, WEST SIDE, NORTH SIDE, EAST SIDE, SOUTH SIDE AND WEST SIDE

NW20 From a point 126.6 metres north of its junction with Old Wolverton Road, for a distance of 77.7 metres in an easterly then northerly then easterly then southerly then westerly then southerly direction

DICKENS ROAD

EAST SIDE

NW21 From a point 85 metres north of its junction with Old Wolverton Road, for a distance of 9.5 metres in a southerly then easterly direction

DICKENS ROAD

EAST SIDE

NW22 From a point 37 metres north of its junction with Old Wolverton Road, for a distance of 9.5 metres in a northerly then easterly direction

OLD WOLVERTON ROAD & DICKENS ROAD

NORTH SIDE, WEST SIDE AND SOUTH SIDE

NW23 From a point on Old Wolverton Road 56.6 metres east of its junction with the centreline of Dickens Road, for a distance of 74 metres in a westerly then northerly direction along Old Wolverton Road and Dickens Road

DEANS ROAD (EASTERN ARM) AND OLD WOLVERTON ROAD

WEST SIDE AND SOUTH SIDE

NW24 From a point on Deans Road 16.7 metres south of its junction with Old Wolverton Road, for a distance of 72.5 metres in a northerly then westerly direction along Deans Road and Old Wolverton Road

DEANS ROAD (EASTERN ARM) AND OLD WOLVERTON ROAD

EAST SIDE AND SOUTH SIDE

NW25 From a point on Deans Road 16.1 metres south of its junction with Old Wolverton Road, for a distance of 32 metres in a northerly then easterly direction along Deans Road and Old Wolverton Road

DEANS ROAD (WESTERN ARM) AND OLD WOLVERTON ROAD


WEST SIDE AND SOUTH SIDE

NW26 From a point on Deans Road 10 metres south of its junction with Old Wolverton Road, for a distance of 30.5 metres in a northerly then westerly direction along Deans Road and Old Wolverton Road

DEANS ROAD (WESTERN ARM) AND OLD WOLVERTON ROAD

EAST SIDE AND SOUTH SIDE

NW27 From a point on Deans Road 10 metres south of its junction with Old Wolverton Road, for a distance of 25.5 metres in a northerly then easterly direction along Deans Road and Old Wolverton Road
