PUBLIC NOTICE

MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (STANTON GATE, STANTONBURY) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes has on 25th June 2024 made an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicles from proceeding along the following part of road to allow Marjen Ltd to carry out swapping of existing mono-pole kit and the excavation of a cabinet bases to include associated ducting works.

For the purpose of the above Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter, wait in or proceed along the following length of road between 3rd July 2024 – 5th July 2024 and 8th July 2024 – 10th July 2024 (24 Hours): -

Stanton Gate, Stantonbury – from its junction with Marlborough Street to its junction with Crosslands.

Whilst the closure is in place the alternative route will be via Marlborough Street, Ashfield, Redbridge, Walsh's Manor and Crosslands (and vice versa).

There will be no exemptions from the provisions of the proposed order except for emergency services vehicles on operational duties.

The closures will be clearly signed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the TSRGD 2016 (The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016). All affected properties will be notified of the forthcoming closures at least one week prior to the works taking place.

The proposed Order will come into operation on 3rd July 2024 and will continue in force for a maximum period of 3 months or until the said works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. If the works are not completed within the maximum period stated, a further order may be made.

Any person committing a breach of the order will be liable upon prosecution to such fine as is prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
