NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council proposes under Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 to construct traffic calming measures consisting of three speed humps on Yardley Road, Olney.

The speed humps will extend for a distance of 4.5 metres, at a height of 85mm and will extend across the entire width of the carriageway whilst maintaining a 300mm gap between the humps and the kerb line.
