PUBLIC NOTICE

MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (QUEENSWAY, BLETCHLEY) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council has on 23rd July 2024 made an Order under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering, waiting or proceeding along the following length of road in order to allow for The Bletchley Big Street Eat event 2024:

No person shall be permitted to enter or proceed along the following length of road.

• Queensway, Bletchley – From its junction with Albert Street to its junction with Princes Way.

Whilst the road closure is in place the alternative route will be via Regent Street, St Martins Street, Cambridge Street, Princes Way and Findlay Way (and vice versa).

There shall be no exemptions from the provisions of the Order except for emergency services vehicles on operational duties.

The Order will come into effect on Saturday 27th July 2024 (Between 5:00am – 10:00pm).

The temporary road closure will be in force on the date shown when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs.

Warning signs shall be erected at the entrances to those parts of the roads to be closed, subject to the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Any breach of the said Order could render a person liable to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (currently £1,000).
