**Post 1 and 2** – Supporting our younger pupils with limited verbal communication to deliver and provide tailored interventions under the direction and support of the class teacher. Experience required of working with pupils who have ASD and ADHD, to support in 1:1 and small group learning activities. Establishing a collaboration with other staff members and professionals is key to enhancing the learning of our children with significant needs.

**Post 3** – Working with individuals and groups of pupils across the school, with a focus on learning and social and emotional support. To liaise with the SENCO and pastoral team to nurture and engage with a supportive and adaptive approach.

Flexibility and patience required to nurture pupils whose day may look different every day.
