Courses are held at MK College campuses, Community Learning MK locations and throughout the community.



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FREE COURSES FOR JOBS

Build on your existing strengths with a free qualification can put you on the path to a better future. Whether you're looking to progress in your current industry, gain better job opportunities or are looking to change your career path, all courses are offered as part of the Government funded 'Courses for Jobs' programme are in sectors where there are identified skills needs.

What is the National Skills Fund?

The government's National Skills Fund programme has created new opportunities for adults to gain a level 3 qualification. This is open to those who are unemployed, or who are employed but earn below the National Living Wage annually (£20,319).

The fund will help eligible adult learners access government funded Level 3 courses, by offering funded training and qualifications.

Who is eligible for free courses?

You can apply to enrol on one of our free Level 3 qualifications if you:

- Are 19 or over and do not already have a Level 3 qualification
- Already have a Level 3 qualification or higher, but earn a salary of or below $\pounds 25,000$ per annum
- Already have a Level 3 qualification or higher but are unemployed
- · Meet funding residency requirements and entry level requirements

What courses are available?

MK College are currently offering the following courses on a part-time basis as part of the Level 3 skills offer:

- Level 3 AAT Advanced Diploma in Accounting
- Level 3 CMI Diploma in Management and Leadership
- Level 3 Diploma for the Children and Young People's Workforce (Early Years Educator)
- Level 3 Certificate in Understanding Autism
- Level 3 Certificate in Understanding Mental Health
- Level 3 Certificate in Understanding Principles of Dementia Care
- Level 3 Certificate in Understanding Principles of End of Life Care



ACCESS TO HIGHER EDUCATION DIPLOMAS

Access courses are nationally-recognised Level 3 qualifications designed to prepare adults to study in higher education. Courses are designed for people who have been out of education for some time, especially those who left school with too few qualifications to be able to go straight to university.

These courses provide a good foundation in the knowledge and skills required for studying at university level so you can be confident and well prepared when you go on to higher education.
