What is the All in 1 MK Card?

The All in 1 MK Card is:

- A form of identification for children and young people.
- A travel concessionary card...all rolled into 1 card!



Can I apply for an All in 1 MK Card?

To qualify for the scheme, you must be:

- Aged between 5 and 18 years.
- A permanent resident of Milton Keynes or attending school/ college/training establishment in Milton Keynes.
- In full or part time education.
- Not in education a pass will only be issued if the Young People's Careers Information, Advice and Guidance Team can verify your details. They can be contacted on 01908 254410. If the Young People's Careers Information, Advice and Guidance Team do not hold your details, identification and proof of address must be provided.
- Home schooling post directly to address on back page.

If you are 18 years of age you qualify up to and including the day before you turn 19 years.

Please note: You will need to re-apply for a card at the age of 12.

How do I apply?

Step 1 Complete the form in this leaflet.

Step 2 Take the form, your £5.00 cheque/postal order payment/ payment details (we are unable to accept cash) and a passport sized photo to your school/college/training establishment.

Step 3 The school/college/training establishment will stamp the form as proof that you are in full-time education. If you are attending a non-compulsory full time further education course, a letter of confirmation from the school/college is also required, stating the nature and duration of the course.

Step 4 The school/college/training establishment will send the form, with the photo, along with your payment to the All in 1 Card Section at Milton Keynes City Council. Your card should arrive 7 - 10 days after processing.

How much does it cost?

From 1st September 2017 All in 1 MK Cards are issued at a cost of £5.00 (non-refundable).

To use it as a concessionary travel card, you have the following options:

- All in 1 Single fare £1.20 (this will apply on local bus services and on MK Connect)
- Weekly pass fare on local bus services £11.00
- 4-weekly pass fare on local bus services £36.00
- A new £2.20 day return is to be introduced (on local bus services only)

Prices correct at time of print.

Each time you travel you must show your All in 1 MK Card and your paper ticket to the driver.

Stagecoach only issue single trip tickets; all other operators issue all three ticket types.

We will not refund bus fares incurred while applications for new or replacement passes are being processed.

Using the All in 1 MK Card for travel:

The All in 1 MK Card can be used on most local buses within the Milton Keynes City Council area. They cannot be used for cross-boundary travel. Money lost due to lost tickets is non-refundable.

There is no time restriction.

Using the All in 1 MK Card as a form of identification:

The All in 1 MK Card **can** be used as a form of identification in places where you need to prove your age, such as when buying age restricted products, eg. DVDs or when entering an age restricted location, i.e. the cinema, as long as the place where it is being presented accepts it as a form of ID.

Lost validation receipts

It is important that you look after your tickets, as we are unable to refund any monies or provide a duplicate ticket in case the ticket is lost or mislaid. You will need to purchase a further ticket if your original is lost, destroyed or mislaid.

Lost/Stolen All in 1 MK Cards

Lost/stolen All in 1 MK Cards should be reported as soon as possible by phoning 01908 252558 between 09:00 and 17:15, Monday to Friday (excluding Bank Holidays). A £10.00 non-refundable charge is made for all lost/stolen All in 1 MK Cards, you can make a payment by cheque, postal order, debit or credit card. We are unable to accept cash payments. Stolen cards should be reported to the police. If you have a crime reference number the £10.00 charge will be waived.

All in one MK Bus Card issue fee

The current fee for issuing an All in 1 MK Bus Card is £5.00. We cannot process your application until payment is received. You can pay by Debit or Credit Card. You can also pay by cheque or postal order made payable to "Milton Keynes City Council". We are unable to accept cash.

If the applicant is in receipt of FREE SCHOOL MEALS, the All in One MK Card will be issued free of charge.
