We have recently opened Autistic Spectrum Condition units at Germander Park and Southwood Schools, both part of the Boulevard Primary Partnership federation (along with Downs Barn School). The units currently have one class but will grow each year eventually to two classes at Germander Park and three classes at Southwood (each with 8 pupils). All children hold EHCPs.

We are in search of teachers who are motivated by the challenge of supporting pupils with ASC, who can inspire our pupils and help them to enjoy their time at school and their learning. Each teacher will lead a small team of support staff in each class of 8 pupils. This is an exciting time for the schools with this newly created provision and as such provides wonderful opportunities for a teacher to be involved in the infancy and development of the classes.
