Milton Keynes City Council as the Local Highway Authority proposes to establish a controlled (toucan) crossings on Barrosa Way, Whitehouse, under section 23(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act).

The proposed toucan crossings come as a result of road safety concerns and congestion issues at school pick up and drop off times.

The average speeds on Barrosa Way are between 14.3 and 15.5mph.

The Council will continue to monitor the way in which highway facilities are used and address any issues that come to its notice and following meaningful consultation with all stakeholders do what it considers necessary to facilitate the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and pedestrian traffic.
