MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (HIGH STREET (PART), NEWPORT PAGNELL) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council intends to make an order under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 to allow the switching on of the Christmas illuminations and related street festivities in the said road on Saturday 30th November 2024. The effects of the closure will be as follows:

No vehicle shall be permitted to enter or proceed along the following part of Road

High Street, Newport Pagnell from its junction with Cedars Way to its junction with Ousebank Street between the hours of 8.00am and 8.00pm on Saturday 30th November 2024.

The following local diversion routes will apply: -

South-westbound traffic approaching from Northampton Road should proceed via Ousebank Street, Riverside, St John Street, Silver Street and Bury Street;

North-eastbound traffic approaching from Wolverton Road should proceed via Marsh End Road, Willen Road, Monks Way, B526 Tickford Street/St Johns Street, Riverside and Ousebank;

Northbound traffic approaching from St John Street - going north-eastbound should proceed via Riverside and Ousebank Street;

Northbound traffic approaching from St John Street - going south-westbound should proceed via Silver Street and Bury Street.

There shall be no exemptions from the provisions of the order other than for vehicles being used in connection with the Christmas illuminations and related street festivities.

This order will affect all classes of vehicle.

Warning signs shall be erected at the entrances to those part(s) of the road to be closed, subject to the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Any breach of the proposed order could render a person liable to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (currently £1,000).
