PUBLIC NOTICE

MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS WITHIN STONY STRATFORD) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE AND RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council, intends to make an order under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 for the purpose of preventing obstruction in the following roads in Stony Stratford, Milton Keynes whilst the annual Christmas Lights Switch-on and Lantern Parade and related street festivities take place on Saturday 30th November 2024. The proposed Order will affect all classes of vehicle and will have the following effects:-

Christmas Lights Switch-on and related festivities (between 07.00 hours and 22.00 hours):-

No vehicles will be permitted to enter or proceed along High Street, from its junction with Church Street to its junction with Wolverton Road and London Road.

The alternative route for south-west-bound local traffic will be via Church Street, then left onto Silver Street, left onto Horsefair Green, then onto London Road.

The alternative route for south-west-bound heavy goods vehicles will be via Queen Eleanor Street and Wolverton Road.

The one-way traffic restriction in New Street will be temporarily suspended to allow two-way traffic whilst the High Street closure is in operation.

Christmas Lantern Parade (between 16.00 hours and 19.00 hours):-

No vehicles will be permitted to enter or proceed along the following lengths of road:-

London Road - Between Woolrich Gardens and High Street/Wolverton Road;

High Street – Its entire length;

Church Street – Its entire length;

Silver Street – Between Church Street/Mill Lane and Calverton Road:

York Road – Its entire length.

There will be no alternative route as the roads will re-open as soon as the parade has passed through, except for High Street which will remain closed.

Any breach of the said Order could render a person liable to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (currently £1,000).
