We are looking for a teacher to join our Galley Hill team in Stony Stratford (KS2-KS5) as we move to full capacity of 6 classes. The students that attend Galley Hill have high sensory needs, limited communication and difficulties with emotional regulation. All the students that attend Galley Hill present with behaviours that challenge regularly.

Key to the role will be learning what engages each student, how they learn and how they are

motivated, channelling these factors into how you teach each subject, so that every student gets the most out of every day. You will inspire your students to enjoy a range of subjects, bringing each lesson to life, engaging them in a love of learning.
