(THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES) (LONG STREET, HANSLOPE) (40MPH SPEED LIMIT) (No.2) ORDER 1999) REVOCATION ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) (2) (3), 4 (2) and 124(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to make the above Traffic Regulation Order.

The general effect of the above proposed Order will be to revoke the existing 40mph speed restriction along Long Street in Hanslope and replace it with 30mph by virtue of street lighting.

Milton Keynes City Council is now carrying out statutory consultation on the above proposal. Copies of the proposed Order, together with plans showing the general arrangements and a statement of reason, may be inspected on the Council's website at: www.milton-keynes.gov.uk/consultations.
