

Officers Remuneration Note 2024-25

Example 1

Teacher A has a salary of £60,000 from 1 April 2024, they received a 6.5% inflation increase in September 2024, so £63,750.

$$£60,000 \times 5/12 = £25,000$$

$$£63,750 \times 7/12 = £37,188$$

Total £62,188

Total to record on officers remuneration note is £62,188

Example 2

Teacher B has a salary of £63,750 but they started their employment 1 September 2024.

$$£63,750 \times 7/12 = £37,188$$

This is below the officers remuneration threshold of £50k so should not be included on the return.

Example 3

Teacher C has a salary of £120,000 from 1 April 2024 but they left 31 August 2024.

$$£120,000 \times 5/12 = £50,000$$

This meets the officers remuneration threshold of £50k so it should be included on the return, please also add the employment end date on the return.
