## MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (HIGH STREET, STOKE GOLDINGTON) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Milton Keynes City Council has on 8<sup>th</sup> April 2025 made the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to enable City Fibre to carry out installation of duct on 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2025 – 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2025 (9:30am – 4:30pm each day).

The effect of the above Order will be to temporarily close part of:

High Street, Stoke Goldington – at its junction with Dag Lane.

Whilst the above length of road is closed the alternative route will be via B526, Horton Road, Newport Road, Hanslope Road, Tathall End, Hanslope Park Road, Park Road, Long Street Road, Forest Road, Wootton Road, (and vice versa).

The Council is satisfied that the temporary closure Order is necessary to enable works to be carried out on the highway. The temporary Order will come into effect on 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2025 and remain in effect for a period of 3 month and will take effect at times during the above period only when works are required and only when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs, which will be erected in advance of any closure.

There will be no exemptions from the provisions of the proposed Order except for emergency service vehicles on operational duties.

The closures will be clearly signed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the TSRGD 2016 (The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016). All affected properties will be notified of the forthcoming closures at least one week prior to the works taking place.

Any person committing a breach of the order will be liable upon prosecution to such fine as prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
