

PUBLIC NOTICE

MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (BOOKER AVENUE, BRADWELL COMMON) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council has on 8th April 2025 made the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, in order to enable National Grid to carry out LV connection works between 28th April 2025 – 2nd May 2025 **(24 Hours)**.

The effect of the above Order will be to temporarily close part of:

Booker Avenue, Bradwell Common – Outside Number 42.

Whilst the above length of road is closed the alternative route will be via Booker Avenue, Stokenchurch Place, Ibstone Avenue (and vice versa).

The Council is satisfied that the temporary closure Order is necessary to enable works to be carried out on the highway. The temporary Order will come into effect on 28th April 2025 and remain in effect for a period of 3 month and will take effect at times during the above period only when works are required and only when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs, which will be erected in advance of any closure.

There will be no exemptions from the provisions of the proposed Order except for emergency service vehicles on operational duties and residents of Streatham Place.

The closures will be clearly signed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the TSRGD 2016 (The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016). All affected properties will be notified of the forthcoming closures at least one week prior to the works taking place.

Any person committing a breach of the order will be liable upon prosecution to such fine as prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
